#### **Canteen**

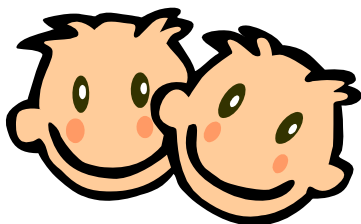
For those people who were not aware, the canteen will be now be open on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.
