CSIRO Visit

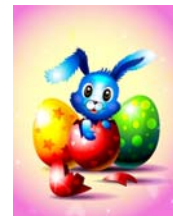

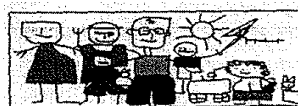
