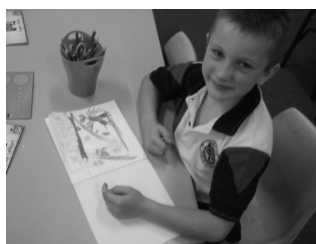


Book Club
